Please note:	
Hot showers or baths	Watches are not resistant to leakage when worn in hot water. The expansion and contraction of the air inside can allow water to be drawn into the case.
Leather Straps	Leather straps are not suited to immersion in water or swimming.
Digital watches	Digital watch buttons must not be operated when wet, as this will open the seal.
